





Year 6 Homework w/c 8.11.24

<p style="text-align: center;">Times Table Rockstars</p> 	<p>Please note, there is a curfew set each day so that you cannot access TTRS too early in the morning or late at night.</p> <p>Remember, you have to complete 10 minutes of garage before you can access any of the other game features. We are doing lots of work around fractions for the next few weeks, which requires you to have very secure knowledge of times tables so the more practice you can do the better.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> 	<p>There was a technical issue with the maths.co.uk homework last week and Miss Taylor's class could not access it. Therefore, this week, we are resetting the task so that Miss Taylor's class can complete it and Mrs Tilley's class have got no maths homework to make up for the fact that you have already done the task.</p> <p>Miss Taylor's class, you have been set the following task:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Y6 Arithmetic A (you may find the fractions questions – Q5, Q6 and Q14 – tricky as we have not yet covered this) <p>Where it says to show your workings, you can do this in your homework book if that is easier.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">SPaG</p> 	<p>Last half term, we learned how to use semi-colons effectively so let's see what you can remember!</p> <p>Add another independent clause after each of these main clauses using a semi colon to separate them. Remember, the second clause should be closely linked to the first, e.g. <i>Churchill was an excellent wartime leader; he is the reason we were ultimately victorious.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) World War 2 was brutal. (tell me why it was brutal) b) Britain's air force was superior to Germany's. (tell me how it was superior) c) Fighting in the war was terrifying. (give a reason why it was terrifying) d) The air was heavy with smoke. (give a reason why it is full of smoke) e) From the distance came an unmistakable sound. (tell me what it was) f) I was paralysed by fear. (tell me why) <p>If you are struggling to remember how to use semi-colons, this top tip should help – write the sentence with a conjunction linking the two clauses and then take out the conjunction and replace it with a semi-colon, e.g. <i>Churchill was an excellent wartime leader and he is the reason we were ultimately victorious.</i></p>
