






## Year 6 Homework w/c 18.10.24

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Times Table Rockstars</b></p> 	<p>This week, 21 children from Miss Taylor's class and 23 from Mrs Tilley's class completed their 10 minutes of garage, well done to them for their teamwork! There is a new battle on TTRS for our classes – who will be victorious? Please note, there is a curfew set each day so that you cannot access TTRS too early in the morning or late at night. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reading</b></p> 	<p>Reading is so important so please ensure you are reading every day.</p> <p>Perhaps you can come in with an amazing book recommendation for someone else in our class. Maybe write the name and author down for them on a post it so they will remember it.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>This week we have been learning about BIDMAS. Using your knowledge of the order of operations solve these calculations:</p> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; justify-content: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 20px;"> <math display="block">8 \times (6 - 2) + 3 =</math> <math display="block">6 \times 5 + 56 \div 7 =</math> <math display="block">12 \div 4 \times 12^2 =</math> </div> </div> <p>Put brackets in the correct place to make these calculations correct:</p> $11 - 4 \times 9 - 10 = -15$ $2 - 6 + 8 + 4 = 8$ $7 \times 4 - 5 - 11 + 9 = 3$ $12 + 11 \times 5 - 5 + 10 = 72$
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SPAG</b></p> 	<p>In SPaG this week you have learnt how to use the subjunctive form.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use <b>were</b> instead of <b>was</b> when writing about a wish, possibility or action. e.g. If I <b>were</b> to get injured, I could return home.</li> <li>Use <b>be</b> instead of <b>are/is</b> to talk about important events in the future. e.g. It is vital we <b>be</b> prepared in case of invasion by sea.</li> <li>Take the <b>s</b> away from verbs for important events which must happen in the future. e.g. It is important that the community <b>keep</b> up their morale.</li> </ol> <p>You should write 3 of your own sentences in your homework book - in role as your wartime character - which use each example of the subjunctive form.</p>
