However, they can tell you that part of the theme will involve us putting on a **performance**.

Therefore, for your homework this week, we would like you to prepare a **short audition**.

Every child will do an audition as every child will be participating in the performance, in one way or another.

There will be different types of parts including: main acting parts, solo singing parts, singing as a group parts, small acting parts, dancing parts etc.

Please prepare an audition that is in line with the sort of part that you would like.

For example, if you would like a singing part, then you will need to sing for us.

If you want a main acting role, you will need to do some acting for us.

If you would like a main part involving singing AND acting, then we will need to see a little bit of both!

At minimum, **every child** will read out a passage from a book so if you are struggling with what to perform, do this.

If you do not prepare for this, you will still be doing it on the day and will have to do it on the spot from your reading book, so it would be much better to be prepared!

If children would like to perform in groups or with a friend, that is absolutely fine however this must be arranged outside of school or at play times.

Children may use music or props (within reason – nothing too much!) for their audition. We are happy to get karaoke tracks up on YouTube or music up on Spotify as long as children are able to tell us what they want.

We will be holding the auditions on Wednesday 8th February so you have until then to prepare. We hope that giving you this homework this Friday means that you have plenty of time to prepare and potentially arrange meeting up with friends if needs be. These auditions will be in front of your teachers and Year 4 peers.
