

Roman Baths Year 3 Visit

02 May 2025

Dear Parents,

On **Thursday 12th June 2025**, the Year 3 children will be visiting the Roman Baths in Bath to further enhance their learning about the Romans in Britain. The coach will leave at **8.15am**, so we ask that the **children arrive at the classroom between 7.45 and 8.00 am. We aim to return by 4.30pm**, a slightly later pick up time than usual to make sure that we get the most out of our visit. Children will need to wear school uniform for the visit and bring a snack, packed lunch, plenty of drinks and a light waterproof coat in a bag that they can carry on their back. Any school lunches booked online for 12th June will need to be cancelled. The children will not need any spending money.

The cost of this visit is £25.00 per child and includes entry to the Roman Baths, an educational workshop and the price of the coach. The visit needs to be paid for online **via Arbor**. Please make your payment no later than Monday 2nd June 2025. Whilst the cost of the visit is a voluntary contribution, the visit may have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received. If you have any problems with payments, please make an appointment to see either Mrs Thorp or Mr Groves as soon as possible*.

*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claim certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). NB This is not to be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) which is provided for all EYFS/KS1 children, or Pupil Premium Plus Funding which is provided for all Looked After Children.
