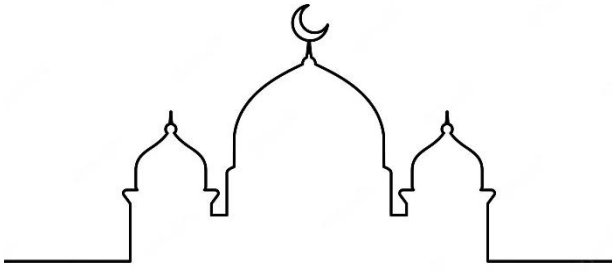

Year 3 Visit to Green Lane Mosque

Dear Parents,

As part of our Religious and World Views Education (RE) topic we are asking the question 'How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?'. To support this learning, we will be visiting the 'Green Lane Mosque' in Birmingham on Tuesday 8th April 2025. The aims of the visit are to help the children gain a greater understanding of Islam and will include a tour of the Mosque. The visit will take place during the school day; we will be leaving at 9:00am and arrive back at approximately 12.30pm. Please make sure that children have a water bottle and snack in school with them on this day. No special clothing is required as the children will be wearing their school uniform, but they will be asked to remove their shoes whilst inside the Mosque.

Entry to the Mosque is free, so we are only asking for a contribution towards the coach cost which will be £5.00* per child. Please make your payment no later than Friday 4th April via Arbor.

As a gesture of thanks and goodwill we feel it would be appropriate to make a donation toward the Mosque's Foodbank, donations will then be shared amongst the local community, we are therefore asking that, if you are able, please send any packet or tinned goods prior to the visit so we are able to create a hamper to take with us.

*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claim certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). NB This is not to be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) which is provided for all EYFS/KS1 children, or Pupil Premium Plus Funding which is provided for all Looked After Children.

Whilst the cost of the visit is a voluntary contribution, it may have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received. If you have any problems with payments, please make an appointment to see either Mrs Thorp or Mr Groves as soon as possible.
