

Shhhhh Top secret! Year 1 Visit The County Museum at Hartlebury

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like this to be a **SECRET**; please **DO NOT** share this letter or any information included with your child, so it does not spoil it for the other children in Year 1.

As part of our 'Elving Around' theme, we are planning a visit to 'The County Museum' at Hartlebury on **Thursday 5th December 2024**. Whilst we are there, we will be taking part in a Toys from the Past workshop and a Victorian Schoolroom workshop.

We will be leaving, by coach, after registration, and will return to school by **3:30pm**. We ask that every child comes to school dressed appropriately for outdoor activity – trousers (no skirts please), warm layers, a waterproof coat, trainers and hats and gloves are essential. School uniform **does not** need to be worn.

Children who have ordered a school lunch on the day of the visit will need to cancel their online booking and complete the attached form below, but will still need to bring a drink in a backpack. If your child usually brings a packed lunch on this day, they will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink in a backpack.

The cost of this visit will be £14.50 per child. This consists of the entrance fee, transport costs and costs of both workshops. Please make your payment no later than **Thursday 28th November 2024 via Arbor**. Whilst the cost of the visit is a voluntary contribution, the visit may have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received. If you have any problems with payments, please make an appointment to see either Mrs Thorp or Mr Groves as soon as possible.

Children who have ordered a school lunch on the day of the visit will need to cancel their online booking but will still need to bring a drink in a backpack. If your child usually brings a packed lunch on this day, they will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink in a backpack. Please [click here](#) to complete the attached form regarding medication requirements and ordering a school lunch. You will need to complete this form by **Thursday 28th November 2024**.

*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claim certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). If you think you may qualify please go to <https://www.worcestershire.gov.uk/council-services/childrens-services/schools-education-and-learning/free-school-meals> NB This is not to be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) which is provided for all EYFS/KS1 children, or Pupil Premium Plus Funding which is provided for all Looked After Children.
