

## Year 2 Trip to the Think Tank, Birmingham Science Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our theme after Christmas will be 'Up, Up and Away' where we will be comparing two significant people: Neil Armstrong and Amelia Earhart. We will become 'history detectives' and look at different sources of evidence to discover more about them both.

As part of our theme we are going to take the children to the **Think Tank** museum in Birmingham on **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2025.**

The total cost of this visit will be £23.00 per child. This consists of the entrance fee to the museum, coach costs and an educational workshop titled 'Destination Space: One Big Journey'. Please make your payment no later than **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 via Arbor.**

Whilst the cost of the trip is a voluntary contribution, the trip may have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received. If you have any problems with payments, please make an appointment to see either Mrs Thorp or Mr Groves as soon as possible.

On the day of the trip, we will be leaving by coach, after registration and will return to school ready for normal collection at the end of the school day. Children will need to bring a small rucksack or similar so that they can carry their lunch around with them. Packed lunches can be ordered from Aspens by completing the Microsoft form below or alternatively you can supply your own. N.B. All other food orders placed for this day via the Aspens website will need to be cancelled. The children will also require at least two drinks to last them throughout the day.

Please [click here](#) to complete the Microsoft form regarding consent for the administration of medication and the ordering of a packed lunch from Aspens. This should be done no later than **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025.**

\*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claim certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). NB This is not to be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) which is provided for all EYFS/KS1 children, or Pupil Premium Plus Funding which is provided for all Looked After Children.
