## Year 2 visit to Worcester Cathedral



Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Religious Education unit '*What makes some places sacred to believers?*' we have arranged a visit to Worcester Cathedral on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. The visit will include a tour of the cathedral, along with a workshop on the role of the cathedral as a place of Christian worship. It is a fantastic visit and a great opportunity to find out about our local history too. We will be leaving school, by coach, after registration and returning before the end of the school day. Children need to come to school dressed in normal school uniform. This is a full day visit so all children will need to bring a drink and snack in a backpack as well as a packed lunch. Children who have ordered a school lunch on the day of the visit will need to cancel their online booking. The cost of the visit will be £12.50 per child. This consists of the tour fee, workshops and coach costs. Please make your payment no later than **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May** via Arbor. If you have any problems with payment please make an appointment to see either Mrs Thorp or Mr Groves as soon as possible. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium\* then the cost of this visit will be covered by school.

\*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claim certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM).
