Dear Parents,

As part of our current theme, we have planned a visit to the Roman Baths on **Thursday 25th June 2026**. Whilst we are there, we will be taking part in some exciting workshops as well as taking time to explore the actual baths themselves. We will be leaving school at **8.00am**, so we ask that the children arrive at school for 7:45am. We aim to return to school by 4.30pm, a slightly later pick up time than usual to make sure that we get the most out of our visit.

The total cost of the visit is £27.00 which covers the cost of entry to the Roman Baths, the educational workshops and the coach. This visit is to be paid for online via Arbor. Please make your payment no later than **Monday 22nd June 2026**. Whilst the cost of the visit is a voluntary contribution, the trip may have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received. If you have any problems with payment, please make an appointment to see Mrs. Thorp as soon as possible *.

*Please note your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding if you or your partner claims certain benefits such as Income Support/Job Seekers (Income based) etc. This means there may be funding available to pay for your child to go on school visits and they would also be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). Packed lunches are only provided for children who are in receipt of free school meals. If you have already ordered a school lunch for your child online via Aspens for this day, please cancel it and send them in with a packed lunch.
